

McKinney-Vento Homeless Services

The **McKinney-Vento Homeless Education Assistance Act** is a federal law that ensures immediate enrollment and educational stability for **homeless** children and youth. **McKinney-Vento** provides federal funding to states for the purpose of supporting district programs that serve **homeless** students.

If you meet the following criteria, please contact the District administration for information on assistance available through the school;

1. Share housing with another person due to loss of housing or economic hardship.
2. Live in a motel/hotel, camping grounds, or temporary shelter in a trailer park due to lack of alternative adequate housing.
3. Living in emergency/transitional shelters or abandoned in a hospital.
4. Have a primary residence that is a public or private place not normally designated for sleeping for human beings
5. Living in a car, park, public spaces, abandoned buildings, substandard housing, bus/train station or similar setting.
